# WARRANTY POLICY OF BRIDGESTONE RETREAD TIRE (The "Warranty Policy")

This Warranty Policy applies to any "**Bridgestone Bandag**" retread tires for trucks, buses, and light trucks which manufactured by Thai Bridgestone Co.,Ltd. ("**TBSC**") and sold by Bridgestone Sales (Thailand) Co., Ltd. ("**BSTL**") to Bridgestone Authorized Dealers or End Users in Thailand (the "**Products**").

1. Definition

"Bridgestone Authorized Dealers" means dealers that have official permission to sell products from BSTL;

"COC" means any customer case; customer-owned tire casing;

"CBB" means any stock case; stock casing provided by BSTL; and

"End Users" means the ultimate consumers of products regardless of the seller.

2. This Warranty Policy covers the Products against failure due to defects in workmanship, materials, and casing and subject to certain exceptions as set forth in Sections 8-14 below. Any damage attributable to normal wear and tear and/or improper usage, incorrect or improper mounting, dismounting, storage, labor, or service charges will be out of warranty scope.

## <u>Claim Process</u>

3. The End Users must contact a Bridgestone Authorized Dealers or a sales representative of BSTL, from which the Products were purchased, as the case may be, to start the claim process.

4. The End Users must submit the claim application form provided by BSTL and deliver the Products to the Bridgestone Authorized Dealers, from which the Products were purchased from, then BSTL will arrange transportation and conduct the tire inspection.

5. To consider whether the defects are covered by this Warranty Policy, the Products shall be inspected by a Technical Service personnel designated by Thai Bridgestone Co., Ltd. ("**TBSC**"), and the inspection result from TBSC shall be final.

#### Warranty Credit Calculation

6. Credit Calculation for Failure in Workmanship or Material

6.1 The Products that display failure in workmanship or material under warranty conditions shall be credited at the warranty credit amount, which is determined by the purchase price (including Bridgestone brand tube & flap if the End Users purchased a complete set). The credit calculation will be based on the remaining tread on a pro-rata basis pursuant with the below table:

6.2 If the Products display no measurable tread for the inspection, the credit calculation will be based on the production date and adjustment date following below table:

7. Credit Calculation for Failure in Casing

7.1 Retread Tire displaying a casing related failure under warranty conditions shall be credited at Warranty credit amount, which is determined by the purchase price (including Bridgestone Brand tube & flap if the End Users purchased a complete set). The credit calculation will be based on the remaining tread on a pro-rata basis pursuant with the below tables:

# Exclusions of Warranty

8. Products damaged due to improper assembly or storage.

9. Products damaged due to misusage or used in other than normal operating conditions (such as wheel misalignment, wheel unbalanced, defect of brake system, shock absorber, improper tire inflation pressure, overloading, curbing, flat spots caused by skidding or panic stops, vandalism, effected from oil/chemicals/fire, destroyed or crashed, running during no air pressure, damage by intention, or any other misusage).

10. Products damaged from road hazards such as nails, bolt, rock, glass, curb, or anything stuck into tire groove or tire case, or vehicle parts falling off.

11. Failure of non-Bridgestone tube or Flap leading to retread tire failure.

12. Products damaged due to incorrect rim fitment.

13. Due to many variable factors affecting tire life, any claim for short tread life will not be considered.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> C Grade means the COC Products with the second retread and more and beyond, or the COC Products with specific casing condition(s) that agreed by End Users to retread with limited warranty conditions.

14. Products damaged or claimed outside warranty period, please refer to table 14-1. The warranty period starts from manufacturing week and year located at retread tire sidewall.
